## GENERAL INSTRUCTION BY CBSE TO GUIDE STUDENTS APPEARING IN BOARDS EXAMINATIONS-2020

### CLASSES – X & XII

---

1. That last entry in the examination centre is 10:00 a.m. for whatever reason, no student will be allowed after 10:00 a.m. in the examination centre. No re- examination will be conducted for such students who have not reported in time.
2. Students to visit their examination centre prior to the examinations to confirm the location, distance, traffic condition etc. They should leave their home much in advance so that they reach examination centre as per schedule and on time.
3. No student will be allowed to leave the examination centre before the examination is over.
4. Students to carry only Blue / Royal blue ball point / Gel/Fountain pen, pencil, eraser, sharpener, Geometry instruments, colors, brushes, Admit Card and School Identity Card as per requirement in a transparent Pouch.
5. Students not to carry mobile, other electronic items and the barred items mentioned below.
  - Mobile & other electronic items are not allowed inside examination hall.
  - Students are not allowed to carry any Printed/Written Material inside the examination hall.
  - Students are not allowed to carry Food Items/Snacks inside the examination hall (some exceptions to diabetic students).
6. Students to wear proper school uniform for appearing in the examination.
7. Students to follow all the instructions given to them by the Assistant Superintendents (Invigilators).
8. Students to complete entries on answer book and on question paper correctly and neatly.
9. Students not to get indulge in any unfair practices. If found, they will be booked under unfair means activities and action will be taken accordingly.
10. Students not to believe in fake videos and messages uploaded on social media regarding leakage of question paper or forward them.
11. Students not to give ear to rumors and they should not spread rumors too. CBSE will make efforts to identify such videos and messages on social media platform, lodge an FIR against involved people and provide the information of such links on Board's website.
12. Students to maintain discipline in the examination centre, protect the furniture etc. and not litter and ensure cleanliness.
